Environment Day with the Coast Guard

he Maharashtra United
Nations Association (MUNA)
in collaboration with the
Indian Coast Guard (ICG) and the
UN Information Centre (UNIC)
observed World Environment Day on
5 June aboard the Coast Guard ships
ICGS Samudra Prahari and INS
Sankalp at Mumbai. The event was a
first of its kind initiative between
MUNA and the armed services that
address marine environment
protection in the state. The
celebration was on the theme 'Green
Economy: Are you part of it?'

Deputy Inspector General NV
Narasimha welcomed the guests and spoke about the activities of the
Indian Coast Guard which include safeguarding the Indian coastline as well as protecting the marine ecology and environment. This was followed by the video messages of UN
Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon and UNIC Director Kiran Mehra-

Kerpelman on the occasion of World Environment Day.

The speakers at the event included MUNA Secretary-General A.A. Syed, Executive Chairperson Mohini Mathur, Secretary and Youth Wing President Ashraf Ahmed Shaikh, and DIG Donny Michael. This was followed by a debate between ICG

officials and the members of civil society on 'Environment Protection Consciousness in India'.

This event concluded with the ICG displaying the pollution response equipment on board the indigenously built pollution control vessel *ICGS* Samudra Prahari.
