This society was launched in 1960 and inaugurated by Pandit Jawahar Lal Nehru Prime Minister of India.

The objectives of the Society inter - alia are;

- b) To educate public opinion towards promoting a people's movement for the United Nations.
- c) To interpret and to represent the views, feelings and sentiments of the Indian People in respect of International solidarity and co-operation among men, women and children.
- d) To Promote research information and education about the goals of the charter of the United Nations and the work of the, United Nations System.

Its preamble:

We, the re-presentatives of the United Nations Associations in our respective countries.

Believing that since wars begin in the minds of men, it is in the minds of men that the defenses of peace must be constructed and Believing that the peace must be funded, if it is not to fail, upon the intellectual and moral solidarity of mankind,

Have resolved to combine our efforts to form an association of the peoples and, having agreed to the present Constitution, do hereby establish an international organization to be known as the WORLD FEDERATION OF UNITED NATIONS ASSOCIATIONS.

Its main objective;

to be a people's movement for the United Nations.

IFUNA is affiliated to WFUNA The world federation has more than 100 member countries including India. WFUNA has its Office at UN Building New York and Regional Office in Accra, Ghana and India.

IFUNA's contribution to WFUNA's activities are significant in its working organization. Mr. H.A. Halim, President of West Bengal UNA was elected as President and Mr. Suresh Srivastava is vice-president of WFUNA.

IFUNA had given three Honrary Presidents to WFUNA. Late Mr. S. D. Panday Secretary-General Mr. Ram Niwas Mirdha, President of IFUNA and Mr. H. A. Halim, Speaker West Bengal Assembly.

FUNA has been granted Special Consultative Status by Economic and Social Council of United Nations. This is in recognition of the work done by IFUNA for promoting UN aims & ideals in India. By virtue of this Status, IFUNA can designate official representative to the United Nations - to the UN Head Quarter in New York and UN offices in Geneva & Vienna.

An important Department of IFUNA is Institute of UN Studies. The Institute of United Nations Studies was established in the year 1969 as part of IFUNA, under the Chairmanship of Dr. Narendra Singh, ICS; Judge International Court of Justice, The Hague.

The objectives of the Institute of UN Studies is to impart basic knowledge about United Nations and its Specialized Agencies. To develop awareness of the aims and ideals of the world body and to stimulate a sense of people's participation in its programmes, activities and achievements.

It is a Six Months Correspondence Course on United Nations and International Understanding. Various papers has been formulated to impart knowledge about UN and its various Specialized Agencies. Its structure, organization, aims and ideals as envisaged in its Character.


